## In Brief

This wild walk takes you from a celebrated Surrey beauty spot deep into Hampshire, visiting villages which were hidden from the world outside for centuries. Much of the walk is over heath, brimming with heather and silver birch, with some breathtaking views. The central feature is the string of lakes deep in the forest where the colours change from season to season.



This is a **big zipper** walk which combines **two shorter walks** in this series. You need to browse, print or download the *latest* versions of the following two guides:




Waggoners Wells and Ludshott Common

Boots are recommended because of the length of this walk. A walking pole is also recommended. There are some patches with nettles and brambles, so bare legs might be uncomfortable Your dog will enjoy this walk if he is fairly fit.

The walk begins at the **National Trust Punch Bowl** car park (postcode **GU26 6AB**), free to members, a small charge for others. Alternative free car parks are available. For travel details, see the at the end of the Devil's Punch Bowl and Waggoners Wells walk.

## The Walk



- Begin at the Devil's Punch Bowl car park in Hindhead at the start of the Devil's Punch Bowl and Waggoners Wells walk. This stage finishes at the end of Leg 2 Section 3, keeping straight on instead of turning left. Look for the *zipper* symbol.
- (2) This stage begins at the start of Leg 1 Section 2 of the Waggoners Wells and Ludshott Common walk. Do most of this walk, ending at the head of the Waggoners Wells lakes near the car park, turning **right** at a fingerpost before the ford and bridge. Look for the *zipper* symbol.
- (3) The walk ends by resuming the *Devil's Punch Bowl and Waggoners Wells* walk from Leg 3, finishing at the end of this walk at the Devil's Punch Bowl.

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
